

The BC Association of Professional Archaeologists Proudly Presents the
2019 JUSTINE BATTEN STUDENT BURSARY

The 2019 Student Bursary has been set up by the BC Association of Professional Archaeologists (BCAPA) for one student who will be attending field school within BC in the 2019 calendar year.

The bursary is a non-repayable limited grant of **\$1,500**, with preference given to those students who demonstrate financial need. The selection process will also encourage other criteria such as extracurricular involvement and leadership in the BC student archaeology community, and is meant to supplement, not replace, the selected student's primary source(s) of funding. The bursary is considered part of a student's taxable income for the year by Revenue Canada.

EACH APPLICATION BY AN ELIGIBLE FIELD SCHOOL STUDENT WILL AUTOMATICALLY GET A BCAPA STUDENT MEMBERSHIP FOR 2019 (A \$25.00 DOLLAR VALUE)

Regulations

- The bursary must be used only for the purpose you apply for (field school tuition fees and expenses).
- The successful applicant will receive the bursary upon proof of registration in field school courses.
- Only the successful applicant will be notified of the bursary decision in writing.
- Members of the Awards Committee are excluded as possible references.

Requirements/Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for the bursary the applicant must:

1. Be enrolled in a BC college or university during the 2019 school year;
2. Be enrolled in a field school which will take place within BC during the 2019 school year; and,
3. Complete the Bursary Application form posted on the "Award Committee" page of the BCAPA website (<http://www.bcapa.ca/committees-groups/#awards>) and supplied to the membership via the email list, clearly demonstrating why they are a suitable candidate for the bursary.

Where to Apply

The winning bursary will be selected and authorized by the BCAPA Awards Committee. Completed applications must be submitted to the Awards Committee at: admin@bcapa.ca.

Bursary Application Deadline

Applications must be received by the BCAPA Awards Committee by **5:00 pm** on the deadline date of **May 30, 2019**.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
